JULY 16, 2015 - DAY 1

**Winfield: Lay wreath at Winfield's Veteran's Cemetery. Wreath will be laid at E-Bay's grave.

**Caney: fuel stop

**Coffeyville: Lunch at American Legion Post 20, 811 W 12th Street.

**Pittsburgh: fuel stop

**Ft. Scott: Lay wreath at National Veteran's Cemetery.

**Lenexa: American Legion Post 407, 9550 Pflumm St. Dinner is available at the post. All riders will be released after stop at Post 407 to gas up and go to motels.

JULY 17, 2015 - DAY 2

**Lenexa: Stage at American Legion Post 407, 9550 Pflumm St. Riders meeting at 8:30, depart at 9:00 AM.

**Leavenworth: Lay wreath at National Veteran's Cemetery. Riders will have one hour after ceremony to tour cemetery.

**Hiawatha: fuel stop

**Seneca: lunch at American Legion Post 21, 812 Main St.

**Washington: fuel stop

**Salina: Riders will be released at the motel. Dinner and fuel on your own.

JULY 18, 2015 - DAY 3

**Salina: staging at parking lot of the Ambassador Hotel, 1616 W. Crawford. Breakfast and fuel on your own before staging. Riders meeting at 7:30, depart at 8:00.

**Hays: fuel stop. Will have time at Doerfler's Harley Davidson shop after fueling

**Wakeeney: Lay wreath at Wakeeney Veteran's Cemetery.

**Norton: fuel stop and lunch at the Veteran's Memorial Park. (\$5.00 - brats and pork burgers)

**Colby: Riders dismissed at the motels. Shuttle available from motels to American Legion Post 363, 1850 W 4^{th} St. Food will be available there. Events include a silent auction.

JULY 19, 2015 - DAY 4

**Colby: Stage at Sleep Inn Motel, 2075 Sewell Avenue. Breakfast and fueling on your own before staging. Riders meeting at 7:30, depart at 8:00.

**Garden City: Fuel stop.

**Dodge City: Fuel stop. Snacks available at either fuel stop. Wreath laying at the Veteran's Cemetery.

**Larned: Wreath laying at Veteran's Memorial.

**Great Bend: End of run. Riders dismissed at American Legion Post 180, 1011 Kansas Avenue. Snacks will be served.

SAFETY RULES

- A. Daily rider meetings are mandatory. Before attending the meeting, gear should be packed, bike fueled, and ready to depart.
- B. There will be NO use of alcohol or drugs during the day while we are en route.
- C. All riders must have their lanyards with medical cards on during the ride.
- D. Don't change positions during the ride. If you must break out of your platoon, you will need to go to the back behind the support trailer until the next stop.
- E. Don't use brakes when slowing down, gear down instead. Using brakes only creates a rubber-band effect.
- F. Ride staggered except when instructed to change to single file.
- G. Listen and follow your platoon leader, and follow the rules of the road.
- H. Platoon leaders are going to communicate by CB. Please do not talk on CB's as it will interfere with the communications of the platoon leaders.
- I. Leaders will point out obstructions on the road, please replicate their hand signals so everyone behind knows of obstructions.
- J. Let's have a fun and safe ride safety first.

HAND SIGNALS:

Single File - arm and index finger extend-Slow Down - arm extended straight out, ed straight up palm facing down







Double File - arm with index and middle finger extended straight up



Hazard in Roadway - on the right, point with right foot; on the left, point with left hand





Pull Off - arm positioned as for right turn, forearm swung toward shoulder
